






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#### **SMART TEXTILES: Definition and Markets**



#2 Improve innovation capacity and market exploitation potential of promising SME's and Start-up's manufacturing smart textiles materials, components, products or related technology - create a portfolio of up to 40 trailblazer projects.

#3 Improve the smart textiles innovation support and coaching competences of clusters and other SME support organisations – provide effective SME support at local & regional level

#4 Replicate the systemic approach to cross-sectoral SME innovation and accelerator funding model beyond the SmartX to other markets

3. Implementation of the calls and funding up to 40 projects with up to 60K€ per SME

4. Implementation, coaching and follow up of the SME projects

5. Results dissemination and SmartX accelerator programme replication


